Orders come from everywhere... websites, shopping carts (Shopify, Magento, Amazon...) storefronts, call centers, inside sales, EDI and ERP systems.

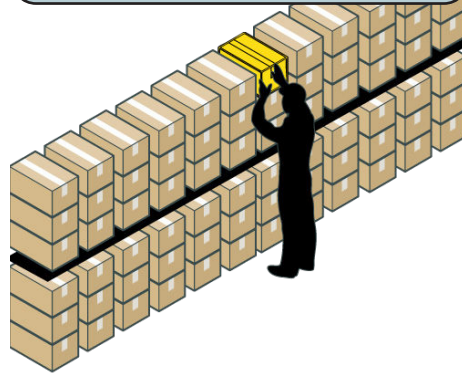
With our integration capabilities using Cadence Data Interchange (CDI) your system can quickly be connected to any order channel.

Put products in their place.

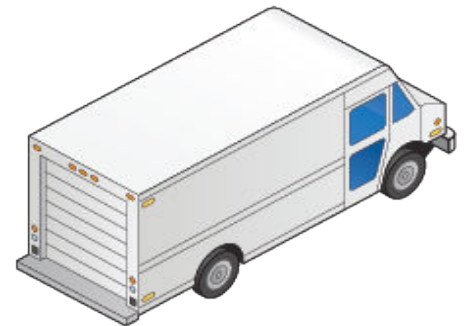
